J. W. Windelknecht's
intention to become a citizen
of the U. S. of A.

To the honorable the Circuit Court for the County of
Cape Girardeau 10th judicial Circuit of the State of Mis-
souri now in session at the May Term 1844.

I Philip Windelrecht, of late an inhabitant of
the Kingdom Hanover in Germany, now residing in
the County of Cape Girardeau and State of Missouri,
do declare upon oath that it is since the last three
years bona fide my intention to renounce all allegiance
to foreign powers and potentates, and particularly to
Ernest Augustus, King of Hanover, and to become citizen
of the United States of America, as soon as the laws
and customs of said states will permit me so to do.
