Plug-ins that self-install will have a .exe file.

The software will self-install an entire folder of necessary files into the appropriate place in the Adobe folder when you use their installer.



However, the installer will need to be directed during the installation to the necessary Adobe folder. Read the instructions provided with the software.

During the installation process, you will be asked to browse to the folder.

Most often the software will be placed in this folder (in both XP & Vista):

C:\Program Files\Adobe\Photoshop Elements x.0\Plug-Ins\Filters **Replace the "x.0" with the version of your PSE.



After installation, the plug-ins are found at the bottom of the Filter drop down menu.
