To the President and to the Honourable the Senate of the United States in Congress assembled-

-  
We the citizens of the District of Cape Girardeau in uper Louisiana for ourselves and our Neighbours; after being informed as we have been; that the Intrigues and machinations of a few Designing, turbulent and Disappointed People of the District of St Genevive Who have maliciously & without any Substantial Reason Propagated Reports unfavourable to the character & conduct of our Excellent Governor James Wilkinson Esqr Evidently Intending to Prejudice the Hounorable Senate against him to the End that they may not confirm his Appointment; We therefore feel it a Duty we owe ourselves. A duty we owe to the Character & Conduct of his Excellancy & a Proper Defference to the Chief Majestrate of the United States Whose Integrety and talents are well known & whose Wisdom and Judgement in the selection of character to fill the Defferent Posts of Honour Profit & trust has long since been acknowledge and approved.

We therefore Request & Petition your Honours to Receive this as a proof of our Entire approbation of his appointment of Governor to our Terrytory & our unlmitted Confidence in the Wisdom, Judgement & Integrity of the Commander in Chief of the United States forces now administering the Office of Governor over our Territory; We can safely Say; that the whole Tenor of his Conduct since he arived here has been such; as ought to have satisfyed and contended the great majority of the People more Particularly the People of this District who are chiefly all American Emigrants or citizens arived from the States since the Cession with Respect & Defference we have the Honour to be your Most obt Humble servants.

The Territorial Papers of the United States is a 28-volume set edited by C.E. Carter and J.P. Bloom covering many states which transcribe documents on territorial administration. The Territorial Papers of the United States **covering Missouri** are primarily found in **Volumes 13, 14, and 15** compiled by Clarence Edwin Carter, focusing on the Territory of Louisiana-Missouri from 1803 to 1821. These volumes document the administration, land claims, and transition of the territory into statehood.

The St. Louis Genealogy Society has put together an 1805 Missouri Territory Census which appears to be compiled from the documents in The Territorial Papers against Governor Wilkinson. This list does not include William Ross. Why? Possibly because he is included on a letter from 1806, not 1805. From their website: "Following the Louisiana Purchase, negative rumors circulated about Governor Wilkinson. The residents of the St. Louis area showed their support for Wilkinson by sending letters to the president. This collection is called the Wilkinson Memorial. The residents who signed the letters lived in St. Louis, St. Charles (SC), St. Ferdinand (SF), and Ste. Genevieve (SG). In addition, residents from Cape Girardeau and New Madrid areas of the Louisiana Territory are included; however, Cape Girardeau and New Madrid residents are not indicated by a location designation. ## A SYNOPSIS

William Ross joined other citizens of the District of Cape Girardeau in the then Upper Louisiana territory on January 6, 1806, in petitioning President Thomas Jefferson and the Senate to allow Governor James Wilkinson to keep his position as Governor. As someone with ancestors in Ste. Genevieve District, it jumps out to me that my Cape ancestor accuses my Ste. Gen ancestor of being untruthful about their statements regarding the Governor. My two lines of ancestors were against each other in 1805/1806! This Petition makes the point that people in the Cape Girardeau District came from the eastern states, but the people of Ste. Genevieve did not (who are French Canadian and Native American.)

Curiosity about this document sent me down a rabbit hole in learning history. I encourage you to search YouTube to watch the many videos about James Wilkinson and Aaron Burr. There are also many books written about this history.

James Wilkinson was the one who tipped off Thomas Jefferson regarding the Aaron Burr conspiracy that initiated a court trial. Aaron Burr had already shot Alexander Hamilton on July 11, 1804, prior to this incident, and that was my only history knowledge of Aaron Burr from my school days.

Aaron Burr was accused of treason for wanting to take over the whole west of Mississippi River to start his own country as a separate Western United States. Aaron Burr was found not guilty at the conclusion of the court trial.

Wilkinson and Burr had a good relationship, being allies between 1804 and 1805 as they planned to explore and possibly steal territory, prior to Wilkinson turning on Burr and in betrayal writing letters to President Jefferson on October 9 and December 18, 1806. Jefferson fought turning over the letters as a matter of national security being allowed to a president. He eventually supplied copies.

It turns out that Wilkinson himself was a scoundrel! He was the highly paid secret "Agent 13" for Spain giving them intelligence from the government which no one knew until 1854, years after his death in 1825, when documents were discovered. He had led a double life being a traitor to Presidents Washington, Adams, Jefferson, and Madison. He was a scoundrel when he became a general in the Revolutionary War at age 20! He bamboozled everyone his entire life, it seems, except some as found in these controversial petitions.

I do note that this Petition was written in January 1806 prior to the Wilkinson letters to President Jefferson in October 1806, making this rebuttal Petition based on rumors that the two were

planning a western rebellion. Wilkinson was Governor from July 4, 1805, at the persuasion of Burr to Jefferson that he be Governor, until he was removed from office on March 3, 1807, due to his involvement in the Aaron Burr conspiracy. Therefore, only half a year transpired between the date he became Governor and the date of this Petition in January 1806.

Wilkinson was the commanding general of the Louisiana Territory as Senior Officer of the U.S. Army from 1796 to 1798 (and again from 1800 to 1812), so the inhabitants of the territory were already familiar with him. Beginning about 1804, Wilkinson had become widely unpopular in St. Louis due to interfering with the review board for land claims and refusing to convene a territorial legislature as commanding general and later Governor. The French were attempting to secure their land claims by winning over American officials, such as Wilkinson, with dinner, business ventures, and political support.

I ponder whether the purpose of this Petition was similar to obtain American concessions of French and Spanish land grants. There are multiple communications written regarding orders to discontinuing digging minerals, which would have greatly affected the people in and around Ste. Genevieve. A requirement for approval of a land concession was farming and improvement upon the land, such as a house, and this did not include mining or other professions, making a loophole to deny a claim. The people in Cape Girardeau did not mine minerals as they were farmers.

Prior to the Louisiana Purchase, Spanish and French land concessions often required habitacion y cultivacion (habitation and cultivation), meaning settlers had to live on and work the land, which generally included farming. The French inhabitants tended to focus on hunting, trapping, digging minerals, and trading with the Indians, but the Spanish thought agriculture was necessary to increase the population.

It is important to look at the time period of the correspondence because the Homestead Act was not until 1862. In the Homestead Act, to "prove up," the land had to be farmed, a house built, and they had to live on the land for five years. At such time, an intent to file proof was published and the claimant filed sworn documents testifying to meeting the requirements. The testimony of witnesses were also sworn to and required by the land office before the homestead certificate was issued. The certificate, or title, was often called a patent and was signed by the President.

I also found many Petitions and a Memorial from all counties in Missouri, such as St. Charles, St. Louis, St. Ferdinand, Ste. Genevieve, and Cape Girardeau that supported keeping Governor Wilkinson, just like page 389 which is the focus of this writing, which was singularly by Cape Girardeau. I have attached some of those pages. I did not find a Petition or Memorial specifically

against Governor Wilkinson by Ste. Genevieve to share, but there certainly was cause of concern enough for many citizens to sign for him. (I may have missed the document and it may yet exist.)

The Petition by those in Cape Girardeau to keep Wilkinson as Governor did not win out as Wilkinson was removed from office in May 1806 and replaced in early 1807 by Meriwether Lewis, of the Lewis and Clark Expedition, who took office in March 1808, but died on a trip to Washington, D.C. in late 1809. Benjamin Howard was Governor of the Louisiana Territory from 1810 to 1812. Lewis's counterpart, William Clark, was appointed the first governor of the Missouri Territory in 1813 by President Madison, serving until 1820. Prior to that, beginning in 1807, he served as a principal Indian agent for the Louisiana Territory. At the same time, William C. C. Claiborne was Governor of the Territory of Orleans from 1803 to 1812 as he managed the transition that became the State of Louisiana.

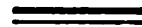

The subscribers Citizens of the Territory of Louisiana, respectfully represent; That they have learned with regret, a Petition is now in circulation, in this Territory, for the appointment of a person, to succeed General Wilkinson, in the Office of Governor, whom we believe will not give satisfaction to the people in general.—Without intending to dictate to The President, we beg leave to observe, that we have the fullest confidence, in the talents, and integrity of both Col<sup>o</sup> Return J Meigs Junior, and Col<sup>o</sup> Samuel Hammond, either of whom, should they meet your approbation, will we believe, by their mildness, and Republicanism, restore harmony to the Territory, and administer its Government, with ability, and satisfaction.—
